Sunscreen forms are available in the classroom and are required for each child. Please complete and return the form to one of the Infant Room teachers, along with your preferred sunscreen and a sun hat for your little one. Fridays throughout the summer months, will include water play as part of their outdoor time! Please bring in "Swimmies" (diapers designed for the water) and a towel each Friday so that your child can participate. In addition, we encourage you to look at all the other fun developmental activities the teachers have planned daily!



Toddler Talk

Ms. Cindy and Ms. Sheila are planning lots of exciting activities for our toddlers this Summer! Look for your child's daily "Cuddlegram" for information on your child's day and the weekly folder to keep you up-to-date on the happenings in the classroom. Please complete a sunscreen form and supply your preferred sunscreen and a sun hat to help your little one safely explore their outdoor world. Summer water play fun begins in June. Your child will need "swimmies"(diapers designed for the water) and a towel each Friday. As always, please check your child's cubby each day for art work and cuddlegrams and replenish diapering supplies as needed.



Tales from the Twos

Potty Training is the word of the season in our Two Year Old room! The teachers are focused on guiding each child, who is ready, to reach this ever important

milestone! To help your child succeed, please remember to dress them in easy to remove clothes and keep plenty of pull-ups, wipes and extra outfits at the center. Lots of wonderful activities are planned for the two's class this summer. Please make sure you have completed a sunscreen form, have supplied a non-spray sunscreen and a sun hat for your child so that we can keep them safe from the harmful rays of the sun. Check your child's folder each week for details about upcoming events. Water play will begin in mid-June. Please bring a swimsuit, as well as a towel, each Friday throughout the summer for water play and "Swimmies" (diapers designed for the water) if your child is not yet potty trained.

The teachers are planning tons of fun for the Summer! Weekly activities are posted in the classroom. Please check your child's Friday Folder each week and return it on Monday. School-Age Happenings

It's hard to believe that Summer Camp is right around the corner! Our Summer Camp teachers are planning lots of fun for this year's camp!! Summer Camp Class lists and room assignments will be posted by May 29th. Please pay special attention to the Summer Camp calendar located in the lobby of our building, as it denotes times and places of field trips and other special events planned for the children. With few exceptions, field trips are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays, and swim is scheduled for Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. On field trip days, children who arrive at the center after the bus leaves will have to make other arrangements for care on that day. Swim suits and towels will be needed each Monday, Wednesday and Friday and should be washed and returned each week. If your child arrives after 8:30am on swim days and their class has already gone outside, please make sure your child has sunscreen on and is in their swim suit before joining their group. Also, please remember to pack a lunch for your child each day in an insulated lunch box, as cold storage is unavailable. As your child's safety is our chief concern, please make sure they are properly dressed each day, wearing sturdy footwear and that a sunscreen form has been completed and you have supplied a non-spray sunscreen to keep your child safe from the harmful rays of the sun. We are looking forward to another adventurous summer and are so glad your child can join in on the fun!
